

Bristol City Deanery Uganda Link

Might you be interested in visiting West Buganda, one of our link dioceses?

We are exploring the possibility of taking a group of **eight young adults** to experience life as a Christian in rural Uganda. We would meet and work with a team of local young adult Christians on a tree planting project for the diocese. We would also be involved in evangelistic work with the diocesan Missions coordinator. In addition we would visit some tourist attractions; for example, the source of the river Nile, the Ssesse islands of lake Victoria and a small Game reserve. If you wish to consider joining the party, we would like to talk with you so that we can decide on the viability of such an expedition.



Living conditions will be basic at times, possibly including long-drop pit latrines of the 'hole-in-the-floor' variety. The weather can be hot and dry, and the roads very dusty. Care would be needed to avoid possibly contaminated food and drink, but good food and safe bottled drinks are readily available. The people are lovely, especially the children. Hospitality is wonderful!

Possible programme for a 13 night stay:

- 13.08.10 Fly overnight from Heathrow to Entebbe.
- 14.08.10 Drive to West Buganda to meet Ugandan young Christians
- 15.08.10 Visit local church for worship /meet with Bishop
- 16 – 20.08.10 Tree planting work each morning. Evangelistic visits to schools and/or games with local children.
- 21.08.10 (Possible)Visit Game reserve.
- 22.08.10 Worship in local church.
- 23.08.10 (Possible)Visit Ssesse islands.
- 24.08.10 Return to Kampala to stay in Namirembe Guest House.
- 25.08.10 Visit to Source of Nile.
- 26 - 27.08.10 Visits to special places of interest in Kampala.
- 27.08.10 Overnight flight from Entebbe to Heathrow.

Best estimates of costs:-

1. Flight, taxes, travel insurance and visa	£650
3. Board and Lodging	£300
4. Vehicle hire and fuel	<u>£50</u>
Total cost (without contingencies)	£1000

Anti-malarials and necessary jabs could add another £200 to the cost.
