- Churches are encouraged to bring the whole team of leaders and volunteers to any diocesan training day to maximise team building and learning experience. If a number of people are attending, full details of one delegate per church group is needed for booking purposes.
- Payment is required prior to the date of the training and can be sent with this booking form. Cash and cheques are both acceptable, but please do not send cash in the post. (Cheques made payable to Bristol DBF).
- Parking is available at all venues. Tea/coffee will be provided, **but please bring your own packed lunch**. Confirmation of your booking will be emailed to you upon receipt of your application. Closing date for applications is one week prior to the chosen training day. If for any reason the training day you have booked on is cancelled by us, you will be notified by email and/or telephone call from the youth and children's adviser/administrator.
- While we understand that attendees sometimes have to withdraw at a late stage, we would be grateful if those who have to cancel would inform us immediately if they cannot attend. Your payment is non-refundable unless cancellation is due to special circumstances. If you do not attend and do not notify us, your payment is non-refundable.
- If your church has a budget for youth and children's work, it might be a good idea to ask for the church to pay for the training. If your church does not, still ask as it is to their benefit as well - you might be pleasantly surprised!
