

Guidelines for divorcees

There are special guidelines on marriage in the church if you are divorced. There may well be a way forward, but you will need to talk one of our Partnership Priests about your situation to explore the possibilities for you (please contact the office for this). In certain circumstances the Church of England accepts that a divorced person may marry again and this has been the case since 2002.

There may be a way forward for you to remarry in a church, but you should talk to one of our Partnership Priests about this. Every Partnership Priest will want to help you, though there are some who don't feel able to offer a wedding to couples where one or both of the partners has been divorced. In any case one of our Partnership Priests will want to talk frankly about your past and hopes for the future and will then be able to advise you.

Even if it is not possible to do your wedding, they may offer a service of prayer and dedication after a civil wedding.
